PARENT'S/SPECTATOR'S CODE OF CONDUCT

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in FNSBSD sports/activities by following this Parents' Code of Conduct:

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other student activity.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well being of every child ahead of a personal desire to win.
3. I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
4. I will support coaches and officials working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
5. I will demand a sports environment for every child that is free of drugs and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all youth activities.
6. I will remember that the game is for youth – not for adults
7. I will do my very best to make FNSBSD sports and activities an enjoyable experience for all children.
8. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with courtesy and respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

I understand I may be asked to leave any athletic contest and school grounds should my behavior be deemed to be unsportsmanlike and/or disruptive by a School District administrator or their designee.
